FFA SUCCESSFUL AT NORTH CENTRAL WASHINGTON FORESTRY CONTEST

The Mt. Baker FFA Forestry Career Development Event team placed 1st at the North Central Washington FFA Forestry Contest held near Lake Chelan on Friday, April 24. *Booker Schmidt* was the high individual at the contest, the first ever from Mt. Baker at this annual event out of 112 participants. *Joe Scarpete* placed 4th, *Aaron Leavitt* was 5th, *Matt Cronk* was 6th, *Jarrold Snavelly* was 9th, and *Cody Anderson* was 12th. *Kyle Leech* and *Kurtis Zender* also both placed in the top 20 at the contest.

FFA SUCCESSFUL AT STATE FORESTRY CAREER DEVELOPMENT EVENT

The Mt. Baker FFA Forestry team placed 1st and 3rd out of 13 teams at the State Forestry Career Development Event last Friday in Chewelah, WA. *Booker Schmidt* – 2nd high individual, *Kurtis Zender* – 4th place individual, *Joe Scarpete* – 7th, *Matt Cronk* – 8th, *Jarrold Snavelly* 10th, *Cody Anderson* – 11th, *Aaron Leavitt* also placed in the top 15. The 3rd place team included *Jarrold*, *Cody*, *Kyle Leech*, *Bryce Postelwait*. All team members placed in the top 20 overall. Wenatchee was 2nd place by about 150 points.

The Mt. Baker team placed 1st at every event this year – Wake Robin, Mt. Baker, Wenatchee, and State. This is also the third consecutive state champion for MB in this event; it is a “3-peat” and a tradition. The trip involved camping in the mountains above Chewelah and at Randy Anderson’s cabin in Winthrop. Dr. and Mrs. Dinus also helped coach the team and chaperone the trip.

The first team, *Booker*, *Kurtis*, *Joe*, *Matt*, and *Aaron* will compete at Nationals in October. Donations would be gratefully accepted to help with expenses of the trip. Contact Todd Rightmire.
