CONDITIONS OF THIS SCHOLARSHIP

1. A student applying for this scholarship must be a graduating senior from a Whatcom County High School.
2. The student shall be furthering his or her education in some field of agriculture at an accredited school.
3. All applicants will be notified of the winner.
4. Payment will be made to the school of choice following the receipt of transcript first quarter or semester grades.
5. Completed applications should be to the school counselor or career center and sent to the Cattlemen no later than April 30 of the current school year.

APPLICATION INFORMATION TO BE INCLUDED:

1. An official transcript of grades.
2. A statement of involvement in 4-H, FFA, school and community extra-curricular activities.
3. One page, typed essay indicating interest in agriculture.
4. Three letters of character reference, one from someone in the agriculture field.
5. A letter of acceptance from the accredited school you are to attend.

POINTS TO BE CONSIDERED IN SELECTION:

1. Scholastic rating
2. Interest in agriculture
3. Scholarship application returned in a timely manner
4. Factors noted in application information
