****SCHOOL CLOSURE INFORMATION****

Hazardous weather, floods or unexpected emergencies may force changes in bus transportation schedules and pick-up/drop-off points for Mount Baker Students. Blackboard (automated communication system) will be implemented along with FlashAlertBroadcasting System to communicate with the following local stations:

KGMI 790, KISM 92.9, KAFE 104.1 KPUG1170 and KBAI 930, KWPZ106.5, KZAZ 91.7, KCPQ 13 TV, KOMO 4 TV, KING 5 TV, KONG 6 TV, KIRO 7 TV. Information is announced only when there is a closure or schedule change.

WILL THE BUS ROUTES CHANGE?

If school is delayed, your bus will pick you up later than usual. **School delay 1.5 hour = bus delay 1.5 hour**. For example, if school is starting 1.5 hour late and your normal pick up time is 8:40 a.m., the bus will now be picking you up at 10:10 a.m.

For students living in certain areas, their pick up and drop off stops may change. Some areas in the district are difficult for school buses to maneuver when there is ice and snow on the road. Children who live in these areas may need to catch their bus at an alternate location. These are called **SNOW ROUTES**. You can access Snow Routes on our website.
